Lokkalyan Charitable Trust was started in 2001 in satara district of Maharashtra. It started its activities with a non- formal education and Vocational Training centre for children. Over the years LCTS Focus has been on the development of poor and Marginalized children's .Its activist has diversified in the fields of children literacy, child health rural employment generating skills SHG formation, community health and awareness programmes on various social issues. The NGO is working in rural as urban areas of satara district.

LCT have received support from serval donor organizations as well individuals. Its PAI program has been support sponsorships for children from a network of individual supports clientan foundation has been LCTS consistent partners been involved with its organizational development .The other support grants are its organizational development. Our Activities:

- 1) **TCI Foundation program Kavach**: Started in Jan 2012 The project is implemented through a chain of khushi clinics at satara transshipment hubs where truckers halt for at least 12 Hours network of highways connecting Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai, and Mumbai theses clinics each.
- Serve an inflow of 100 truckers a day on average. The clinic also serves. The local community including workers employed at the halt point. The programme also uses some nontraditional outlets. Such a tea shops tobacco outlets. And roadside cafes and eateries, to distribute condoms while interacting with

truckers, shopkeepers at these outlets provide back ground information about HIV/AIDS and the dangers of not using condemns.

- Project khushi clinic four main components: Clinical management of sexually transmitted infections and related counseling. Because long distance truckers are highly mobile, they need access to medical facility where they travel project clinic has therefore located its khushi clinics 1 major trucker halt point in satara this halt point about 10000 to 15000 truckers a year as they stop to rest to repair their vehicles and like. The project has reached large humble of truckers and other between Jan 2013 to Sep 2014 its treated nearly 5000 people for sexually transmitted infections 80% of them truckers.
- <u>Objectives:</u> To reduce the incidence of various sexually transmitted infections among long distance truckers through appropriate clinical intervention.

Child line Foundation (1098 Child Help line):

child line is Indians first 24 Hour toll free emergency phone outreach service for children in need of care protection linking them to long

services for their care and protection and rehabilitation any child and concerned adult call 1098 and access CHILDLINE service any time of the day Night. To reach out to every child in need of care and protection by responding to emergencies on 1098 and by physically reaching out to children.

• To adapt and integrate telecommunication to Connolly, linking all districts to the services of 1098 and making it available to all children in need of care and protection.

- To provide a platform of networking amongst organizations and to provide linkages to support systems that facilities. The rehabitation of children's in need of care and protections.
- To work together with allied systems (police, healthcare, juvenile justices, Transport, legal, education, communication media. political and community) to create child friendly systems.
- To advocate for services for children that are inaccessible, on existent or in adequate.
- To create a body of NGO and government organizations working with in the national framework and policy for children.
- To be a nodal child protection agency in country, providing child protection services to children in need of care and protection.

Childline is national emergency toll free phone outreach service for the children in need of care and protection operates on the 1098 number and is supported by the ministry of women and child Development(WMCD) Government of India and works in partnership with state governments

Lokkalyan Charitable Trust(LCT) has been appointed as the collaborative organization for setting up, Managing and monitoring the childline 1098 service all over the District .childline 1098 service all over the satara District .Child line 1098 service is cited by the Government of India as Indians response to commitments under the child Rights convention of the united nations to which India is a signatory.

The service focuses on the needs of children living alone on the streets. Child laboures, domestic, workers, run a way children children's of sex workers and sexually abused children.

The Basic objectives of the childline services are as follow:

- To respond to children in emergency situations and refer them to
- relevant Government and non-governmental organization and link them to long

- term rehabilitation
- To great a structure which ensures the protections of the rights of the child as ratified in the UN convention on the Rights of the child and the Juvenile justice (care and protection of children)Act 2000
- To provide a plat form for networking amongst organizations and to strengthen the support systems which in especially difficult circumstances
- To sensitive agencies such as the public, hospitals, municipal corporations and the railways towards the problems faced by these children.
